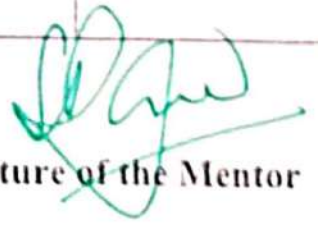

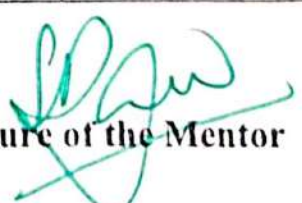

1.0 Introduction

This report is a summary of the group effort of planning, designing and implementing a mobile application for consumer awareness. The project is part of the Community Service Project (CSP).

The term consumer awareness has existed for a long time, but it was first in 1962, encouraged by the US President John F. Kennedy, that an actual declaration about consumer rights was established (The American Presidency Project, n.d.). Consumer awareness is foremost a marketing term referring to the consumer's right to be aware of the products they purchase, but also an ethical conduct for those responsible of the production and distribution of the goods.

The report is structured in the following way: first we give a short description of our motivation for doing this project and our goal for the final application. We then present a review section, first giving an overview of similar products on the market that include consumers and product awareness. The review section closes with a discussion around existing literature on technologies that connects the physical and digital world: RFID, imaging and barcodes. Then follows an exhaustive description of the design process of planning, implementing and evaluating the application, which we believe is the most important part, and also an own section discussing and analysing the design process itself. The report closes with a summarizing conclusion.

1.1 Motivation

Information on regular products offered at most grocery stores are often insufficient and hard to read/understand. Today's groceries-buying consumers may have allergies, be vegan, environmentally interested, and because of that be in need of more profound information about the products they are about to buy. The purpose of this project is to provide them with that information. With the consumer awareness application at hand, we hope to give the consumer the additional information needed - to make it easier to be aware!

There is no doubt that such an application might be useful. But is there a need for it out there? Is the general population aware of the need of more consumer awareness? Anthony Bailey of the

University of Toledo wrote a paper (Bailey, 2005) on consumer's awareness and use of product review websites. These websites exist solely to inform consumers about products, both facts and opinions. One can safely say that taking the information stored on websites and make it more available to users through a mobile application is a step forward.

The paper also mentions that consumers who are aware of product review websites are very likely to use them, though many use them only for reassurance after they purchased a product. A mobile application will possibly shift these statistics more toward checking before purchase, due to the possibility to check a product right then and there when it's in front of you. The existence of this option will aid in reducing the effort of being aware, help consumers be more cost efficient by buying exactly what they want and not things they later will find out is not what they were looking for.

1.2 Goal

The pragmatic goal of this project is to implement a fully functional application for consumer awareness. It should be quick and easy to get the additional information needed about groceries, whether it's the product's origin, ingredients, nutritional facts and so on. The application should also make it easier to compare goods and make effort to give alternatives if a specific grocery is not in stock.

It is also a goal to inspire and encourage the *regular* consumers to be more aware about the products they purchase. Hopefully, the application will function as a useful tool on a daily basis, and become both the regular and the already aware consumer's new best friend. If time permits, the application should also be available in more than one language.

2.0 Review

In connection with the development of the consumer awareness application, it was beneficial to look at existing applications already developed for this kind of purpose. We have also reviewed literature about relevant topics on how to connect the consumer with their products.

A Study on Saving and investment pattern of villagers of Oguru village of Kandukur mandal.

Abstract

This paper aims to examine the savings and investment pattern of villagers through a survey of 80 respondents where data was collected using the structured questionnaire to find the investment and saving patterns of population in the age group 19 and above in Oguru. The respondents were asked about their annual income and to what proportion was the savings to earnings ratio. They were asked about the source information for investment. In addition, what are their objectives while investing. Further, they were asked what type of investment they prefer, i.e. do they invest for long term or prefer short-term investment and what rate of return do they receive for their investment. Then this data was analysed and put in tabulated form in excel. ANOVA test results shows that the sig value 0.746 is greater than the alpha value 0.05 at 95% confidence level, therefore it is concluded that there per cent savings and marital status are Independent. It means married people save less than unmarried people.

INTRODUCTION:

HOUSEHOLD AND SAVING PATTERNS

The Indian economy has grown at an average of 7% in the current decade, with per capita income rising 78% to Rs29, 642 by 2006-07 in this period. How has this affected the average Indian's ability to earn, willingness to spend, and propensity to save? Insurance company Max New York Life commissioned Delhi-based National Council for Applied Economic Research, a think tank, for a Financial Protection Survey in June 2005.

The agency covered 63,016 households, spread over 1,976 villages and 340 towns in 24 states and Union territories. The survey results confirm the wide disparity between urban and rural people.

On average, the urban Indian earns 85% higher than his or her rural counterpart, spends 71% more and saves nearly double—Rs26,762 compared with Rs11,613—every year.

According to the survey, a person's occupation, education, age, location and land holding directly influence his or her income. Households with graduates earn 3.5 times more than those with illiterate ones, and incomes nearly double between the ages of 25 and 66. Salary earners are the cream of urban India, while agriculturists with land are the richest in rural areas.

Wage labourers are the poorest, comprising 62% of the lowest-income households. In addition,

67% of this quintile belongs to the not-so-rich states, with the poorest among them being Bihar

with a per capita income of Rs6,277. The average Indian saves only about a quarter of what he

or she earns—Rs16,039, out of an income of Rs65,041, according to the survey. Some 12% is spent on weddings, social ceremonies and unusual medical expenses. Rural, uneducated and poorer households spend more on food, while expenses on transport, durables and clothing are still quite similar among both urban and rural households. Only about a third of rural households have colour TVs and blenders, with the share rising to more than half in the case of urban India. In addition, financial vulnerability affects both urban and rural India—25% of households spend more than they manage to earn. While more than 80% of Indians save mainly for children's education and old age security, the salaried class saves the most, 33%, of its income. Most of that, though, is eventually spent on medical emergencies. Still, even as Indians like to stock up on cash, they are optimistic about their financial future, and urban

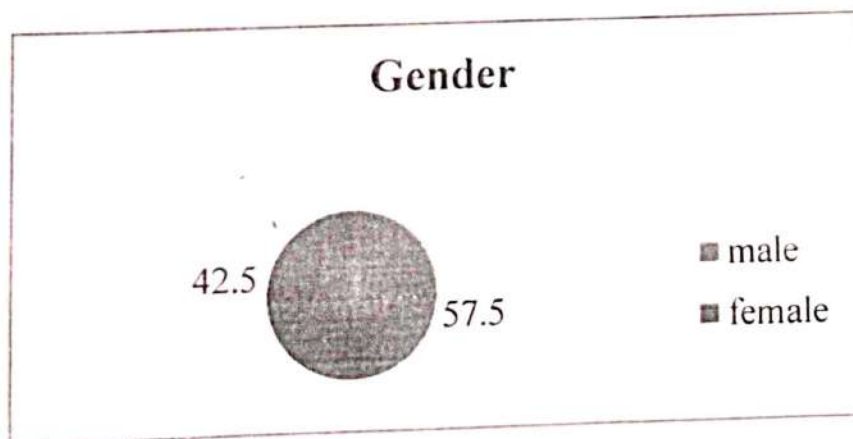


Fig no 4.1 Gender Source-Survey

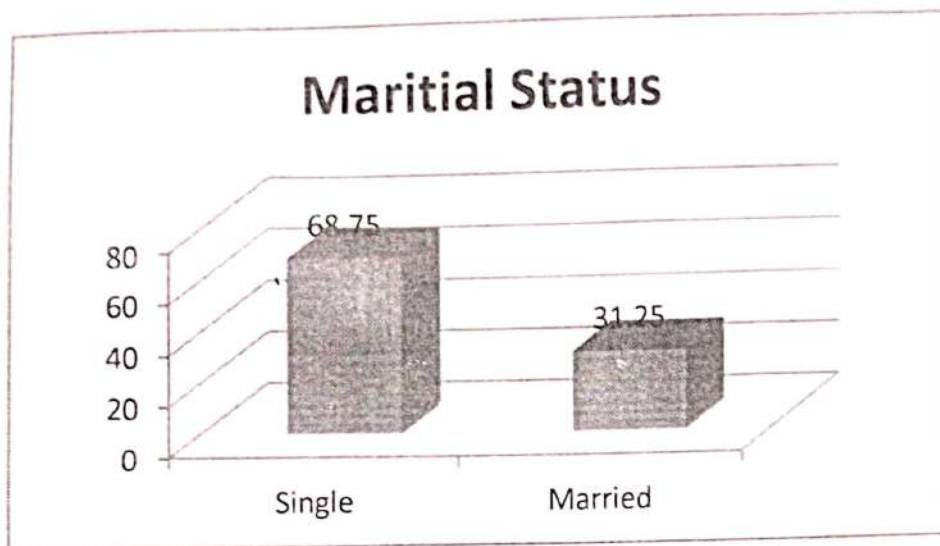


Fig no 4.2 Marital Status

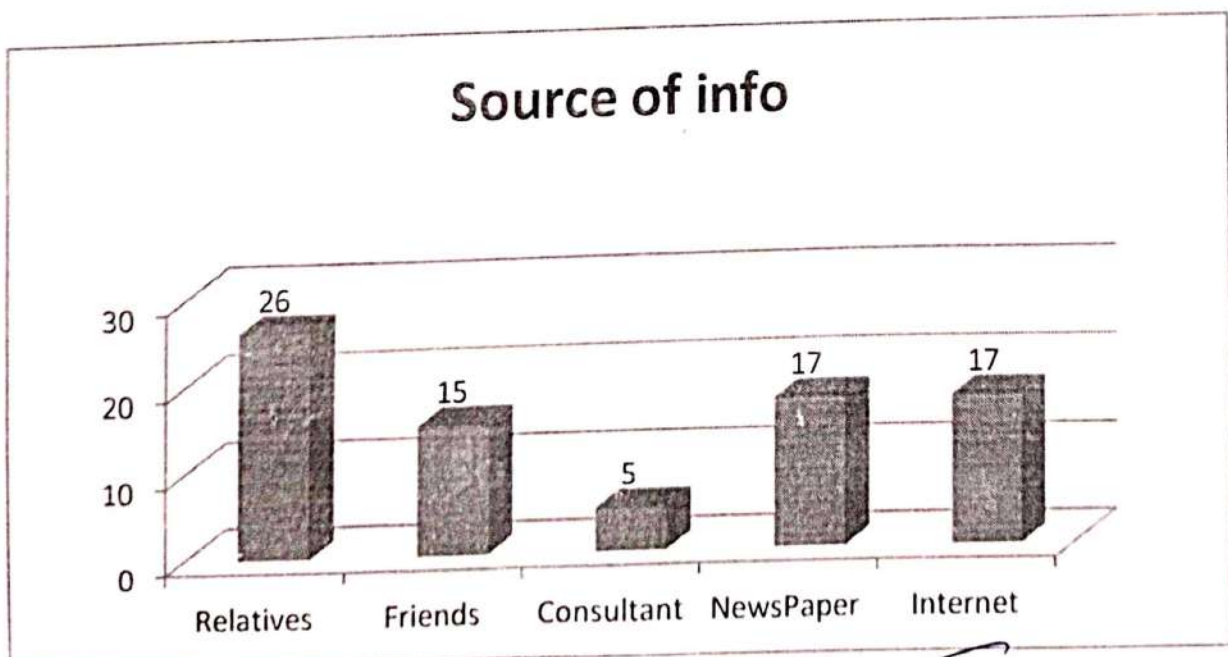


Fig no 4.3 Source: Survey

Among 50 houses survey process I observed that few of people used wifi facility. i.e) 7 houses have wifi facility most of the people used their local networks .

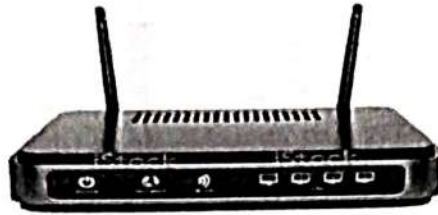

DISH TV Users:

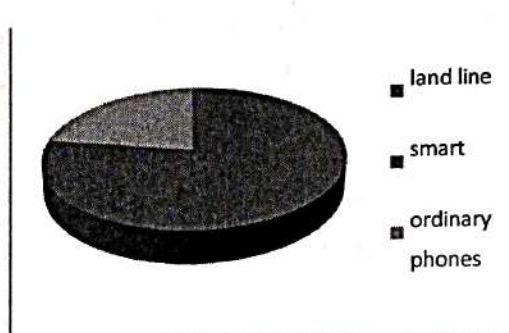

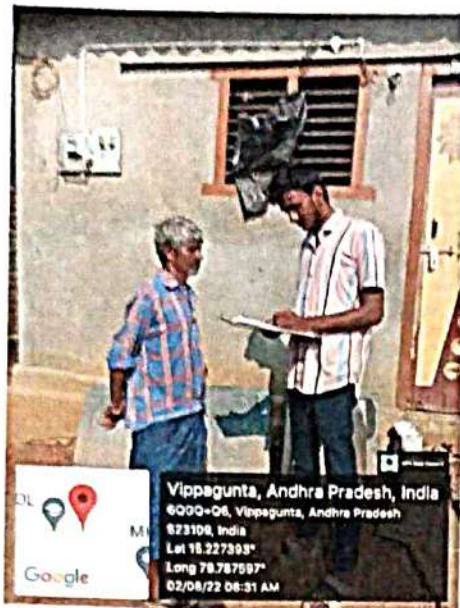

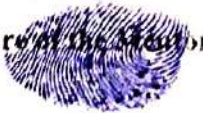
